Introduction

The English Department at SEEU is the largest language department in the University with over 300 students enrolled at undergraduate and postgraduate level. We offer an integrated BA programme which combines language study with literature, linguistics, teaching methodologies and course design. We provide an excellent education in English language and literature which prepares future English teachers for a teaching career - most of our graduates go on to successful careers in English language teaching in Macedonia. The programme also offers opportunities to those who intend to work in translation/interpretation. The SEEU programme also prepares students for postgraduate study in other regional and international Universities. But many successful students choose to continue their studies with the MA in English Language Teaching offered at SEEU as a 2 year part-time Masters degree.

The English Department boasts around 20 full-time and part-time staff including 5 international staff members from USA, Canada and Ireland. Students can expect to study in a supportive environment with a range of resources at their disposal – the Max van der Stoel Library, excellent IT resources across the campus, the learning management system Libri, the Language Resource Centre in the dedicated Language Centre building where the majority of classes are held. Students study English Skills three times per week and can expect to progress from pre-intermediate/intermediate to advanced levels during their studies. Our teachers use a range of teaching methodologies and students can expect active and participative classes which involve students fully in the learning process. Our staff in the English Department are highly motivated and, according to SEEU's staff evaluation scheme, consistently achieve excellence in teaching. Students will find that studying English at SEEU is a challenging and rewarding experience.
